

A bag made by you has an incalculable value and if you make it with a nice stitch and trendy colours you will want to walk it everywhere.

DIFFICULTY

Difficult

MATERIALS

Wooden handles, 20 cm diameter and 2 cm thick.

1 ball of 50 g of cotton - green pistachio colour to work with hook number 5

1 ball of 50 g of cotton - green colour to work with hook number 4

2 balls of 50 g cotton - black to work with hook number 4

Hook used 2.5, 3.5, 4 and 5

Heart shaped metallic ornament.

Stuffing

Markers

Wool needle

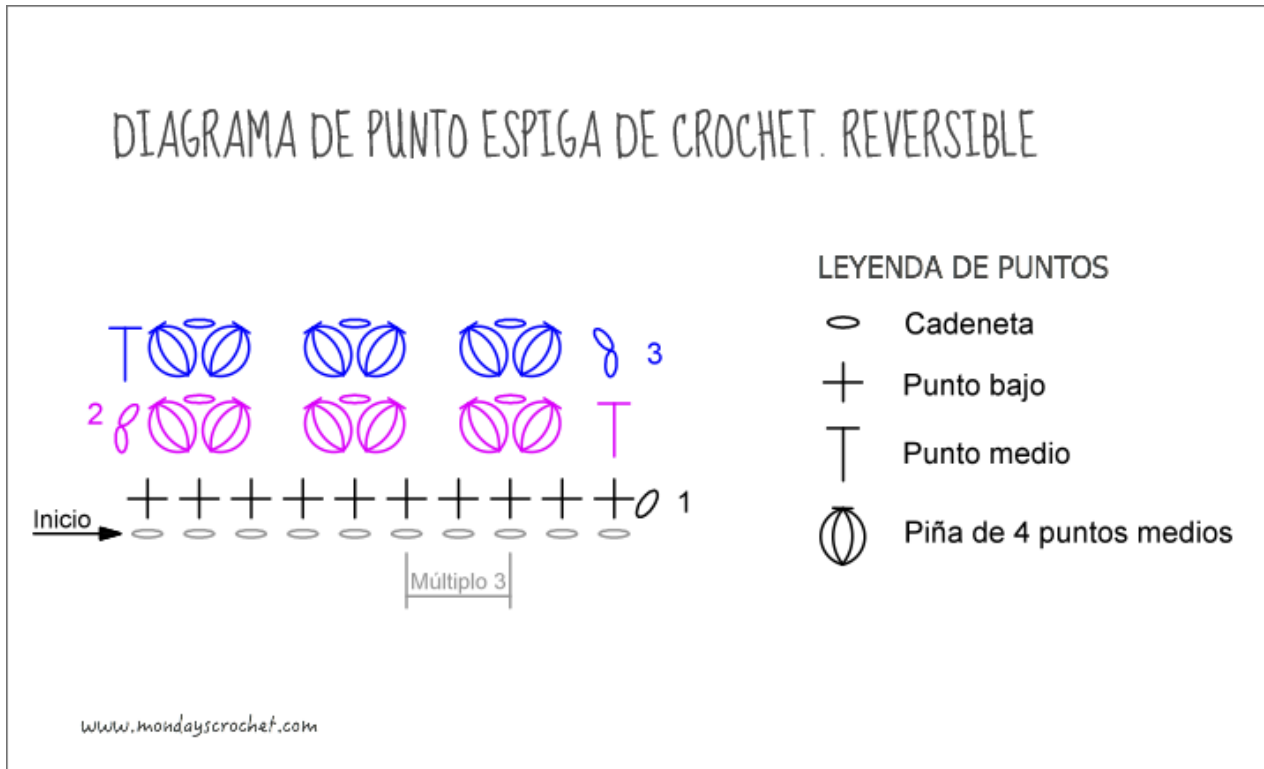
Scissors

STITCHES USED

- Chain (ch)
- Slip stitch (sl st)
- Single crochet (sc)
- Single crochet front loop only (Fsc)
- Puff stitch 3 hdc (Ps3)
- Puff stitch 4 hdc (Ps4)
- Wheat spike stitch (2 puff stitches in the same stitch separated by 1 chain) (Wss)

WHEAT SPIKE STITCH DESCRIPTION

This stitch is formed by two puff stitches in half double crochet in the same stitch of the previous row and separated by a chain. The result is thick, ideal for bags. The hook is introduced several times in the same stitch, so, we recommend the use of cotton.

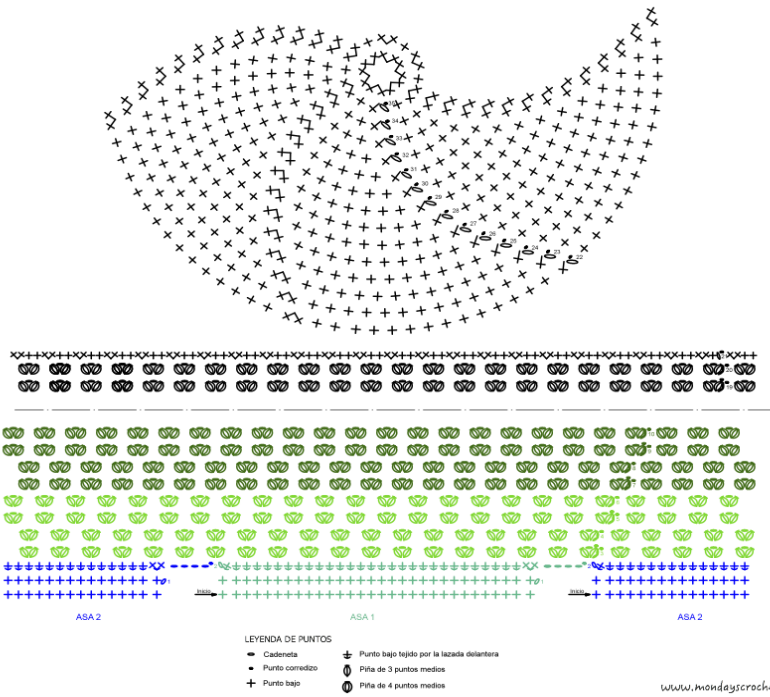
Follow the next 6 steps to make the bag



1. Work around the handle
2. Work around the second handle
3. Join both handles
4. Make the bag
5. Make the circular base
6. Make the ornaments

This bag is made from top down, therefore the wheat spikes are upside down.

STEP 1. WORK AROUND HANDLE NUMBER 1

With pistachio green colour. Hook number 5

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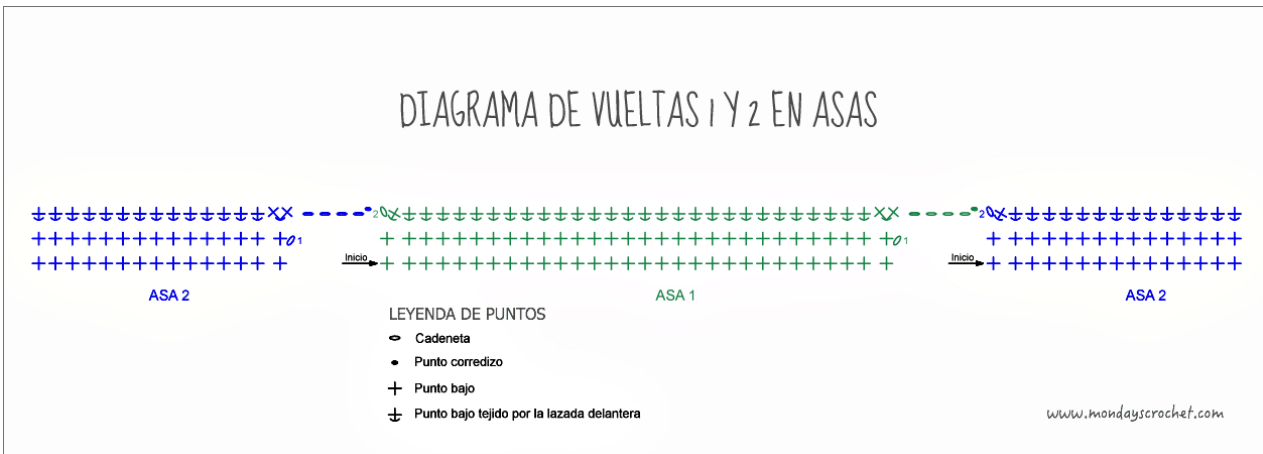
FOUNDATION ROW: 30 sc picking the handle (See photo below).

ROW 1 RIGHT SIDE: 1 ch and 1 sc, 29 sc. 30 sc in total.

ROW 2 WRONG SIDE: 1 ch and 1 Fsc, 28 Fsc, 2 Fsc. 32 sc in total. Finish off with 4 ch.



STEP 2. WORK AROUND HANDLE NUMBER 2



Make handle number 2 as for number 1

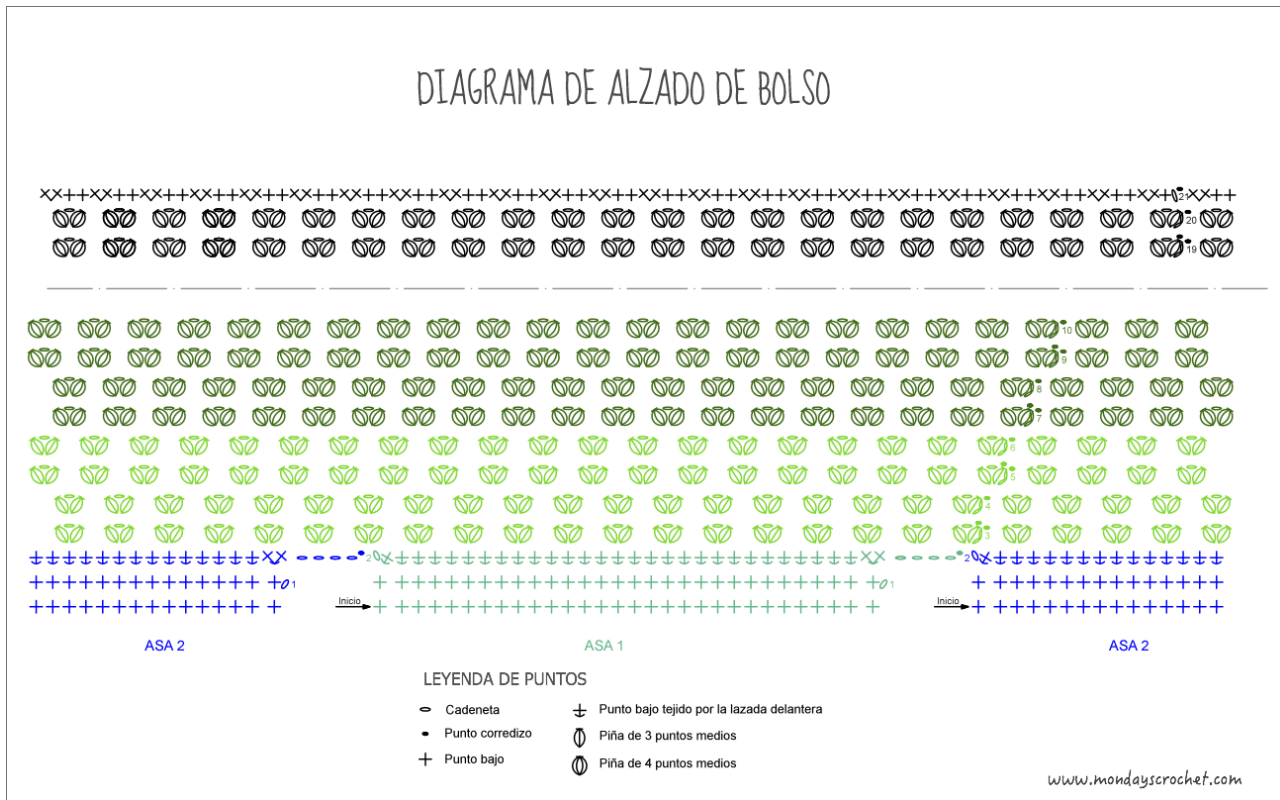


STEP 3. JOIN THE HANDLES

To join the handles make 1 sl st from the end of the 4 ch made at the end of steps 1 and 2. Finish off with a wool needle and cut the remaining threads.

STEP 4. MAKE THE BAG

Work in the round in the right side from rows 3 to 20.



We have a total of 72 stitches: 32 sc in each handle and 4 ch in each end of the handles.

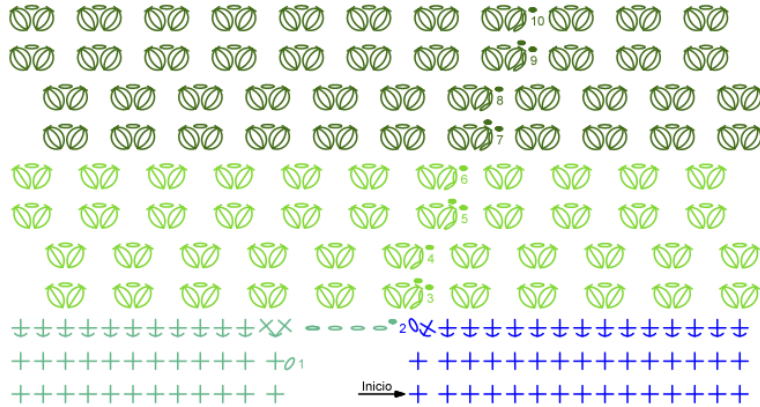
ROW 3 RIGHT SIDE: 2 ch and 1 Ps2, 1 ch to close it, 1 Ps3 in the same sc of the previous row. Repeat Wss. Finish with 1 sl st in the starting ch of the first puff stitch.

ROW 4 RIGHT SIDE: 1 sl st to place yourself in the centre of the wheat spike stitch of the previous row. 2 ch and 1 Ps2, 1 ch to close it, 1 Ps3 in the same sc of the previous row. Repeat Wss. Finish off with 1 sl st in the starting ch of the first puff stitch.



ROW 5 RIGHT SIDE: 2 ch and 1 Ps2, 1 ch to close it, 1 Ps3 in the same sc of the previous row. Repeat Wss. Finish off with 1 sl st in the first ch of the first puff stitch.

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ROW 6 RIGHT SIDE: 1 sl st to place ourselves in the centre of the wheat spike of the previous row, 2 ch and 1 Ps2, 1 ch to close it, 1 Ps3. In the same sc of the previous row. Repeat Wss of 3 hdc. Finish off with 1 sl st in the fist stitch of the first puff stitch.

With dark green

Using a thinner cotton we will make puff stitches in this case od 4 hdc with the same hook.

ROW 7-9 and 11 RIGHT SIDE: 2 ch and 1 Ps3. 1 ch to close it, 1 Ps4 in the same sc of the previous row. Repeat Wss of 4 . Finish of with 1sl st in the first stitch of the first puff sitch.



ROWS 8-10 and 12 RIGHT SIDE: 1 sl st to place ourselves in the centre of the wheat spike of the previous row. 2 ch and 1 Ps3. 1 ch to close it, 1 Ps4 in the same sc of the previous row. Repeat Wss of 4 hdc. Finish of with 1sl st in the first stitch of the first puff sitch.



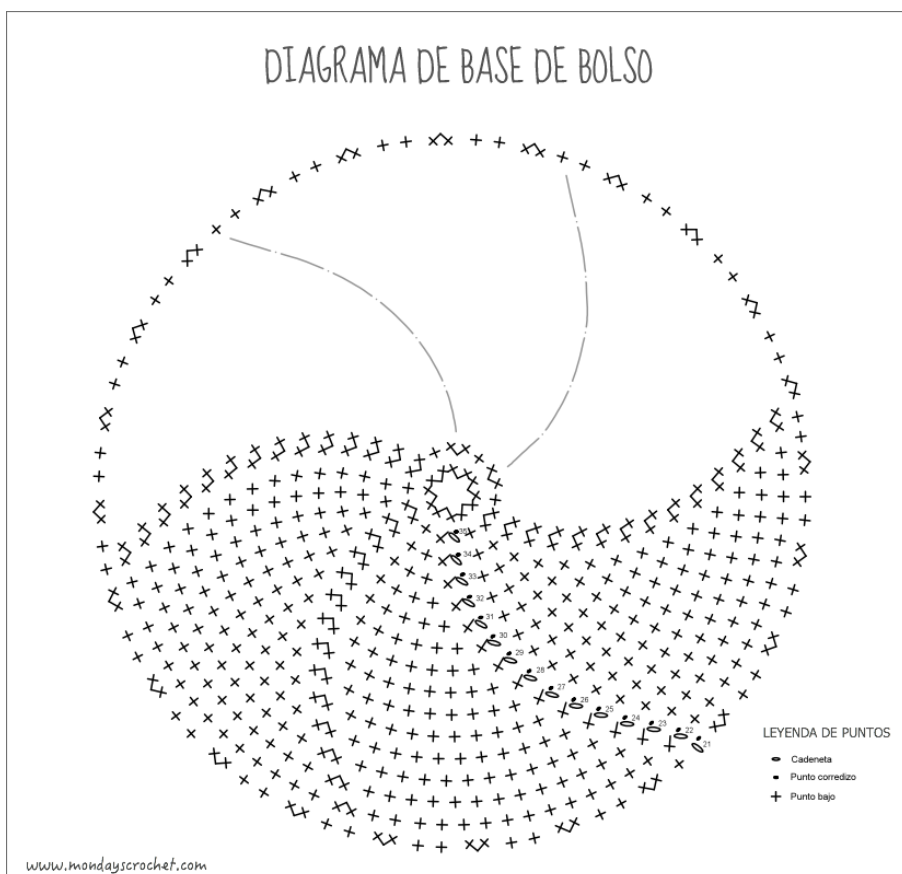
With black

ROWS 13-15-17-19 and 21 RIGHT SIDE: 2 ch and 1 Ps3, 1 ch to close it, 1 Ps4 in the same sc of the previous row. Repeat Wss of 4 hdc. Finish of with 1sl st in the first stitch of the first puff sitch.

ROWS 14-16-18 and 20 RIGHT SIDE: 1 sl st to place ourselves in the centre of the wheat spike of the previous row. 2 ch and 1 Ps3. 1 ch to close it, 1 Ps4 in the same sc of the previous row. Repeat Wss of 4 hdc. Finish of with 1sl st in the first stitch of the first puff sitch.

STEP 5. MAKE THE CIRCULAR BASE

With black and hook number 5.



ROW 21: 1 ch, 1 sc in the fist wheat spike. And 2 sc together, in the second wheat spike. 96 sc in total.
 ROW 22: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row. 14 sc, 1 decrease of 2 sc., 14 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row. Finish of with 1 sl st. 90 sc in total.
 ROW 23: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row, 13 sc, 1 decrease of 2 sc., 13 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row. Finish of with 1 sl st. 84 sc in total.
 ROW 24: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row, 12 sc., 1 decrease of 2 sc., 12 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row. Finish of with 1 sl st. 78 sc in total..
 ROW 25: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row, 11 sc 1 decrease of 2 sc., 11 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row. Finish of with 1 sl st. 72 sc in total.
 ROW 26: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row, 10 sc, 1 decrease of 2 sc., 10 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row. Finish of with 1 sl st. 66 sc in total.



ROW 27: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row, 9 sc, 1 decrease of 2 sc, 9 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row. Finish of with 1 sl st. 60 sc in total.
 ROW 28: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row, 8 sc, 1 decrease of 2 sc., 8 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row. Finish of with 1 sl st. 54 sc in total.
 ROW 29: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row, 7 sc, 1 decrease of 2 sc., 7 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row. Finish of with 1 sl st. 48 sc in total.



ROW 30: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row, 6 sc, 1 decrease of 2 sc., 6 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row. Finish of with 1 sl st. 42 sc in total.
 ROW 31: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row, 5 1 decrease of 2 sc., 5 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row. Finish of with 1 sl st. 36 sc in total.
 ROW 32: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row, 4 sc 1 decrease of 2 sc., 4 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row. Finish of with 1 sl st. 30 sc in total.

ROW 33: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row, 3 sc 1 decrease of 2 sc., 3 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row.. Finish of with 1 sl st. 24 sc in total.

ROW 34: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row, 2 sc, 1 decrease of 2 sc., 2 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row.. Finish of with 1 sl st. 18 sc in total.



ROW 35: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row, 2 sc, 1 decrease of 2 sc., 1 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row. Finish of with 1 sl st. 12 sc in total.

ROW 36: 1 ch and 1 sc in the next sc of the previous row, 2 sc, 1 decrease of 2 sc, decrease. Repeat for the whole row. Finish of with 1 sl st. 6 sc in total.



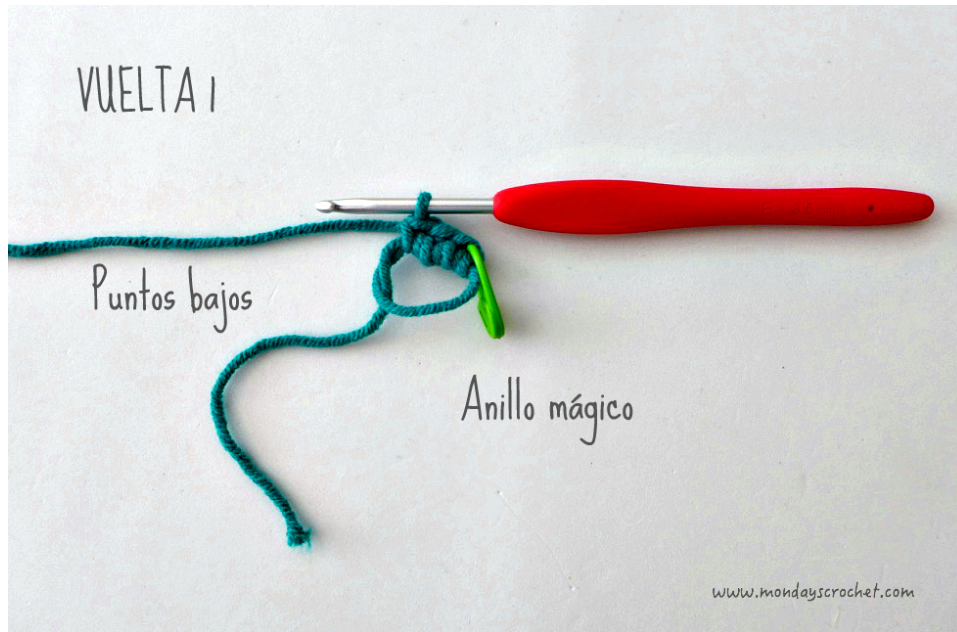
Fasten off using a wool needle the 6 sc remaining. Cut the remaining thread.

STEP 6. MAKE THE ORNAMENTS

Make 2 hearts of crochet with the amigurumi technique.

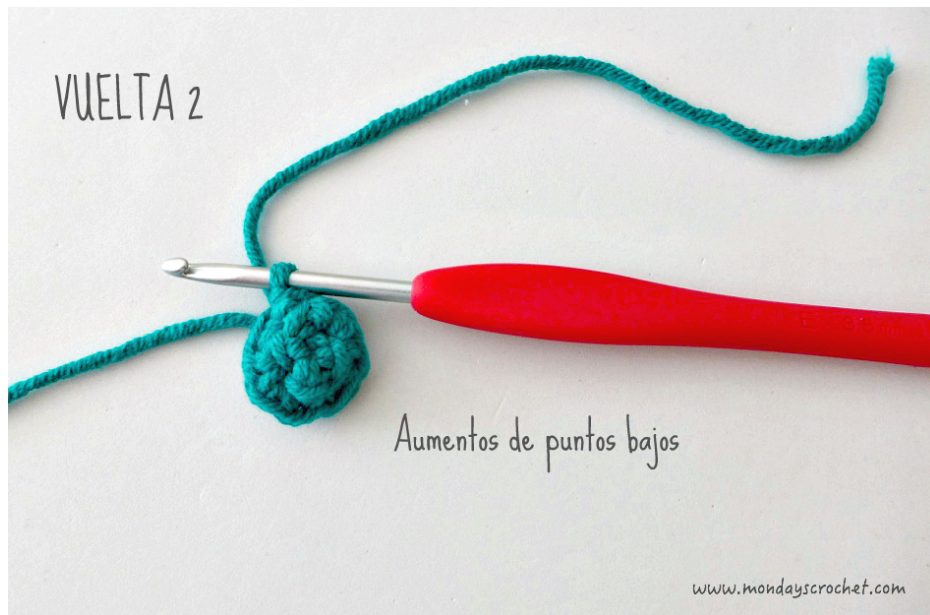
For the green heart use a hook number 3.5 and 2.5 for the black one.

FOUNDATION ROW: Magic ring.

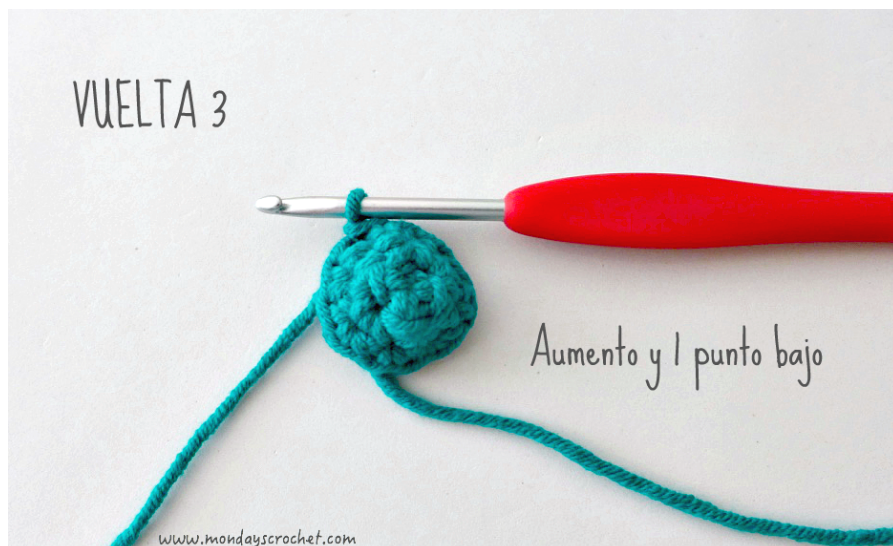


ROW 1: Inside the magic ring 1 ch and 3 sc. Finish off with 1 sl st. 4 sc in total.

ROW 2: 1 ch and 1 sc in the same stitch of the previous row, increase of 2 sc together in each stitch. Finish off with 1 sl st. 8 sc in total.



ROW 3: 1 ch and 1 sc in the same stitch of the previous row, 1 sc in each stitch, increase of 2 sc together. Repeat for the whole row. Finish off with 1 sl st. 12 sc in total.



ROW 4: 1 ch and 1 sc in the same stitch of the previous row, 1 sc in each stitch. Finish off with 1 sl st. 12 sc in total.



ROW 5: 1 ch and 1 sc in the same stitch of the previous row, 2 sc in each stitch, increase of 2 sc together, 2 sc. Finish off with 1 sl st. 16 sc in total.
Fasten off with wool needle. Cut the remaining thread.



ROW 6: 1 ch and 1 sc in the same stitch of the previous row, 1 sc in each stitch. Finish off with 1 sl st. 16 sc in total.
To divide into 2 equal parts make 2 ch and 1 sl st in the centre of the other side of the heart.



ROW 7: 1 sc in each sc of the middle of the heart. In the union ch of the sides work only in one loop. Finish off with 1 sl st. 10 sc in total.



ROW 8: 1 ch, 1 decrease of 3 sc in the front loop. Repeat. Finish off with 1 sl st. 4 sc in total.



Fasten off using a wool needle and cut the remaining threads



Fill the heart with stuffing.



Repeat ROWS 7 and 8 on the other side of the heart.
Fasten off using a wool needle and cut the remaining threads.



This is the result.

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Make chains of different lengths.



Sew the 3 hearts on the side of the bag that you desire.
